The Alzheimer Society of Montreal is currently looking for **On-Call Activity Leaders** for its three Saturday activity centres for people living with Alzheimer's disease and related forms of dementia.

Located in Ahuntsic, Lachine, and Westmount, these centres benefit caregivers by allowing them a period of respite, while also providing a creative and stimulating environment for their clients living with dementia.

The activities and programs offered at the activity centres to both individuals and groups are designed in a collaborative environment, using a therapeutic approach and according to the interests and capacities of each participant. With a staff-to-client ratio of 1:3, our therapeutic activities and programs can be adapted to the needs of each individual.

**Position Requirements:**

- Preferably students in their 1st (second semester), 2nd, and 3rd year of Special Care Counselling, Therapeutic Recreation, CRLT, or a related field;
- Bilingual (French and English), a third language is an asset;
- Availability to work every Saturday (9 a.m. to 4 p.m.);
- Basic knowledge and understanding of Alzheimer's disease and related forms of dementia;
- Experience working with individuals living with dementia;
- Experience in programming and adapting therapeutic activities;
- Capacity to work within a team environment;
- Owning a car is an asset.
