

The Observatory on Aging & Society (OAS), in collaboration with the McGill University Research Centre for Studies in aging, **invites you to participate in its one-hour awareness workshop on ageism, offered free of charge** as part of a grant from the *Québec Ami des Aînés* (QADA) program.
